

Woy Woy FC Registration Policy for 2012 Season

1. Registration policy will be displayed on club website.
2. Fees due in full at Registration. Any Outstanding Fees from previous seasons have to be paid before 2012 registration can be accepted.
3. Players or parents wishing to pay Registration fees by instalments must first apply by written application to the WoyWoy FC committee for approval to do so.
4. The Family and 10 year player discounts will only be given to players registering on the 3 advertised official registration days or via the online registration system.
5. Unregistered Players will not be allowed to participate in any team grading trials.
6. Due to potential insurance liability issues, players will not be allowed to train or play until a registration form has been completed and registration fees have been paid in full.
7. Players with outstanding fees at the start of the season will have their Central Coast Football Player ID card retained by the registrar. The coach or manager of their team will be told not to play them in the team until the fee is paid.
8. Refunds may be granted at the Clubs discretion prior to the season commencing. Once a player has played an official match, refunds will not be given and definitely *no refunds* will be considered after the 1st of May, 2012. When a refund is offered, Woy Woy FC will retain an amount of \$20 as an administration charge.
9. The registration fee will be refunded in full when Woy Woy FC is unable to place a player in a team.
10. Woy Woy FC will charge a 4% surcharge for payments made by credit card except for registrations completed and paid in full via the online registration system
11. Rooster Dollars cannot be used for online registrations but maybe returned to Woy Woy FC for a cash refund. This only applies to players who have registered and paid the 2012 fees via the online registration process.
